Please note the following points:-

1. Punctuality in the School.

- **13.** Parents please note that, you shall not send your ward to any of the teacher's quarter for clarifying the subject related matters or for any purpose including the Private Tuition.
- **14.C.<u>B.S.E Board result of Cl. X &XII</u>**: The result will be displayed on the Notice Board. The Mark Sheet & Migration certificates will be issued to the parent/ Students after its arrival from CBSE Office. An authorization letter to be produced if any parent authorize the 2nd person to collect the same from the School Office. Students those who have issued library books may submit before the collection of certificates and those who have lost the book may need to pay the amount of the book.

15.<u>Admission to class XI on17th&18th June 2016. Time 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon.</u>

Students of St. Joseph's School, NTPC will be admitted to Plus Two (Cl. XI) based on the Merit List. The students should obtain 80% marks in English, Science and Mathematics to take the admission along with character and discipline of the students.(character and discipline of previous years will be considered.)Class XI classes begin from 22/6/2016.

There is no vacancy in any of the classes. Therefore admission is closed. Parents are requested not to pressurize the school authorities for the same.

16.<u>Parents whose wards are presently in C. IX are requested to take notice of the following points by CBSE</u> for the promotion to Cl. X

- * The year-end subject wise grade of a student in class IX is to be calculated on the basis of performance in all formative assessments and summative assessments in scholastic areas as well as grades obtained in co-scholastics areas.
- * In scholastic areas, all the five main subjects i.e. two languages (with highest marks), Mathematics. Science and Social Science are to be considered at par for promotion purpose.

Promotion to the next class

- It is mandatory to appear in both Unit tests & Summative Assessments during the academic year.
- Every student is required to get a qualifying grade D or above in two languages & three main subjects for the purpose of promotion to next class.
- A student getting E1 or E2 grade in scholastic areas in one or more subjects, even after adding grade points from co-scholastic areas in one or more subjects will have to improve his/her performance in one subsequent attempt (Compartment Exam) to obtain qualifying grade D in these subjects.
- If a student fails to obtain qualifying grade D in one or more subjects, even after adding grade points from co-scholastic areas and after availing one improvement chance, he/she will be required to repeat the same class during next academic year i.e. a student must obtain qualifying grade D or above in all the five subjects (two languages & three compulsory subjects).
 <u>Improvement Chance</u>
- After Summative Assessment II in class IX, a student will get only one more chance for improvement to obtain a qualifying grade D through Compartment Exam. This is also applicable to those students who are not able to appear in Summative Assessment due to sickness etc...
